
Goal of this tutorial

- ▶ In a few short steps, you will learn how to create a silhouette graphic you can use for your presentations from clipart, or photos.



Method 1: Extraction

- ▶ To extract a silhouette from existing clipart...




Step 1: Insert clipart

- ▶ Insert Tab | Clipart
- ▶ Type in Silhouette
- ▶ Choose Illustrations type only (no Photos or Other Types)
- ▶ Pick one.
- ▶ Put it on the slide.



Step 2: UnGroup and Delete


- ▶ Right click on the clipart and choose Group | Ungroup.
- ▶ Delete any part of the picture you don't want.
- ▶ You may have to do this twice.



Now you can resize and use how
you wish...



Method 2: Picture to Silhouette





Step 1: Insert photo

- ▶ Insert Tab | Clipart
- ▶ Type in whatever search term you'd like
- ▶ Choose Photos type only
- ▶ Pick one.
- ▶ *Note: It's useful to pick photos with clear lines and angles.*
- ▶ Put it on the slide.





Step 2: Remove background

- ▶ Click the photo to highlight it.
- ▶ Format Tab | Remove Background.



Step 3 Recolor to Black and White

- ▶ Format background | Color – 50% or above black and white.
