- 1. Crop to clean

 Click on Format Ribbon item
- 3. Choose crop.
- 4. Move mouse on four sides of picture to reduce size.

Add Reflection

- 1. Click on Picture
- 2. Click on Format Ribbon item
- 3. Choose Picture Styles.
- 4. Choose a Reflection Style.

- 3. Choose Artistic Effects.
- 4. Choose Diffused Glow style.
